



Behavioral Assessment Inc. Partners with Duke University on an important randomized clinical trial to develop a family and community level intervention, Ser Familia.

Behavioral Assessment Incorporated has now partnered with Duke to conduct a 5-year NIH study on the development of a community level intervention for immigrant families. The study is a follow-up to our previous NIMHD study where we were able to identify syndemic conditions among adult immigrant populations. Our new study, Ser Familia, will begin to address the syndemic conditions of depression domestic violence and substance abuse in a large-scale randomized clinical trial conducted in the research triangle area of North Carolina.
